

Computer Lab

Mary Seat of Wisdom's Computer Lab is designed with a flex Scheduling format. This means that teachers can request certain time periods throughout the week ahead of time for research, visiting educational websites, using software programs as well as learning about web safety. The lower grades do have semi-set times for specific grade level usage according to our computer curriculum and grade level standards. Below is a breakdown of specifics for each grade level:

Grade 1: First Grade comes to the lab once a week specifically to use software to enhance Math and Language Arts skills. They also use the Kidspiration program to do to “authoring” projects from their Social Studies Curriculum.

Grade 2: Second Grade uses the lab for Math and Language Arts enhancement and strengthening of basic facts and skills. They use the Kidspiration program for “authoring” projects in Social Studies . They also will use on-line sites such as Brainpop.com, Enchantedlearning.com, and 50states.com. They are also introduced specific keyboarding skills.

Grade 3: Third Grade begins using our server – based typing program, All The Right Type, to begin a structured learning of the proper mechanics for typing. This program will carry over through fifth grade. Children will visit the lab twice a week for this program alone. Also, teachers use software and websites to enhance Math and Language Arts skills. The “authoring” program, Kidspiration, is used within their curriculum to enhance learning.

Grade 4: Fourth Grade continues using our server- based typing program, All The Right Type, to develop better typing skills. Children will visit the lab twice a week for this program alone. The Kidspiration program is used within their curriculum to enhance their learning program. Websites such as Brainpop.com, Enchantedlearning .com, and Quia.com are also used.
